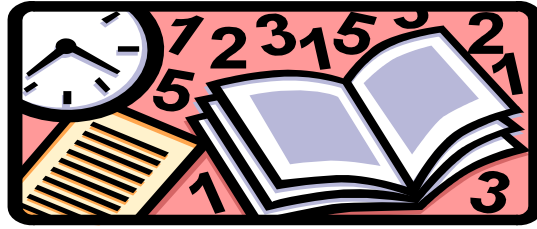

Important Notice Regarding Transportation- Bristol/Warren students will not be able to use the school buses until the proper transportation request form is filled out. These requests forms are available at the public school department office on State St., Bristol, RI. Busing will begin on August 31, 2010.

Being Prepared – The first day of school students should be prepared with a notebook and pen. Teachers will inform the students of their requirements for their particular classes. Some school supplies will be available from our bookstore.

Student Supervision – This is just a reminder to parents that students are not supervised before 7:30am and after 2:30pm. Students who are waiting to be picked up after school must wait in the cafeteria or in another area designated by the Administration. Students who are not after school for a specific purpose **must leave** the building at dismissal. The school administration reserves the right to ask students who are misbehaving or destroying school property to leave the school and wait for transportation outside the building.
